Letter from Fr. Marijan

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

I hope that you and your family are well.

As we begin the journey to Bethlehem, we can imagine you have many questions about how things will unfold regarding Advent and Christmas Masses at St. Mark's Parish given the Covid-19 situation.

First off, it is extremely important to be aware that our church is still limited in the number of people we can accommodate at each mass to maintain safe physical distancing. Currently we are permitted to seat up to 30% of permitted number, and that could change again at any time with updates from the Ontario government.

While we all would like to be physically present at mass to celebrate the Birth of our Saviour, this year it is just not possible for all of us. Fortunately, you are not alone. This Christmas season and always, we stand together in faith as we welcome our Saviour. Whether you participate at home or at church, we are one in the Lord. If you are not able to obtain tickets through registration or would prefer to stay home for safety, spend some time planning for Mass with your family. Rejoice, dress up in your Christmas finest, light some candles and join us in celebration of the Mass from the comfort of your homes.

To help you make safe and informed plans for your family, please review the following information surrounding Masses during the Advent season and for Christmas.

Mass Registration

All parishioners who wish to attend Mass must register on the parish website. Registration to attend mass is required for Saturday at 5PM, Sunday at 9AM and 11AM Masses, as well as the weekday Masses and Sunday communion services (1PM and 1:15PM). This will also be the case for all Christmas masses. In case that all free tickets and spots will be reserved, the parishioners who arrive at the church without registering will unfortunately be turned away as we cannot exceed the numbers allowed by Ontario Public Health. For this reason, we ask you to please plan ahead and register your family for Mass. Registration for weekend Masses begin on Wednesday evenings at 7:00PM.

- If after booking a ticket you discover you are not able to attend the Mass, please email stmarkspastoral@bellnet.ca to let us know so we can cancel your ticket and open it up to someone else.
- Please do not enter the church if you have a fever, feel ill or have been in contact with a COVID-19 positive individual over the past two weeks.

Christmas and New Year's Mass Times

<u>Christmas Eve (December 24)</u>: Masses at 5:00PM (Family Mass), 7PM, 9PM, 11PM (carolling 15 minutes before each Mass). The 7PM Mass will be livestreamed at https://bit.ly/StMarkYouTube.

<u>Christmas Day (December 25)</u>: Masses at 9:00AM and 11:00AM (carolling 15 minutes before the 11AM mass) Communion services at 1PM and 1:15PM. The 9 AM Mass will be livestreamed at https://bit.ly/StMarkYouTube.

New Year's Eve (December 31): Masses at 5:00PM and 10:30PM for Young Adults (open to all), followed by Adoration at 11:30PM

New Year's Day (January 1): Mass at 10 am. This year January 1st, the Solemnity of Mary the Mother of God, is not a day of obligation.

Registration for Christmas and New Year's Masses will open on December 16 at 7PM at
www.stmarkstouffville.ca (seating is limited for both church and hall).
If you arrive for Mass without registering beforehand, access into the church is not guaranteed (we
cannot exceed the maximum limit of people allowed by Ontario Public Health).
If you have a ticket and you arrive late, you may not get a seat if the church is already full.
Those who have registered for a ticket and who are first to arrive will be seated upstairs. If we are
able to open the hall, others who arrive later with a ticket, will be seated downstairs to watch via
livestream

Communion Service Option (no Mass)

If you are not able to obtain a spot at Mass because registration is full, please consider attending one of our Communion Services after Masses on Sundays. These services are approximately 10 minutes in length, consisting of a reading and an opportunity to receive the Eucharist. As a preparation for this service, we ask you to watch the Mass online beforehand. The Communion Service takes place every Sunday at 1:00PM and 1:15PM, and will also be offered on Christmas Day, same times. Online or if not possible, in person registration is required to attend.

Confession

Need to come for confession? Reconciliation times are Saturdays, 9:30-10AM and 4:00-4:45PM, or by appointment. Advent Confession Days in preparation for Christmas are on December 11 from 9AM to 9PM (lunch break from 12PM to 1PM), and December 19 from 9:30AM to 4:45PM. To request a specific reconciliation appointment, please call the Parish office at (905) 640-6954 ext. 107.
